



# Dartmouth-Lake Sunapee

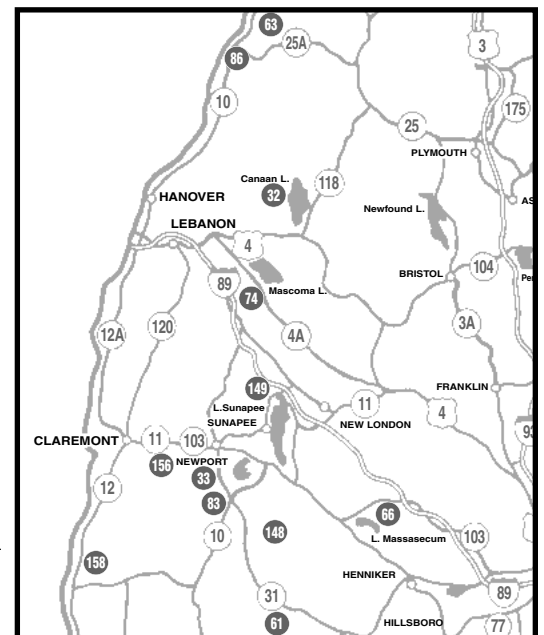


*This robust yet understated region of New Hampshire is a remarkable combination of two very distinct regions: the Upper Connecticut River Valley and Lake Sunapee.*

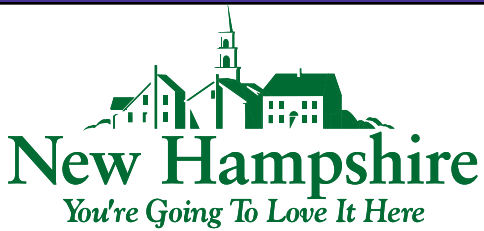
